# Zenith-Stromberg Carburetors Adjustment

by Bill Unger, Newsletter Editor

### **Preparation**

pre warm engine

detach crankcase breather hose

### remove air cleaner plenum and mounting plate (1/2")

leave air cleaner horns attached to carb bodies

remove dashpot piston dampers

remove vacuum balancer hose between carbs and cap closed disconnect 1° throttle rod clip and detach rod from throttle spindle

loosen one of the 1° throttle spindle clamps so that carbs operate

### independently (1/4" socket)

disconnect 2° throttle rod clips at each carb and detach rods from throttle spindle pull 2° rods forward and tape to manifold to keep full open fully close idle trim screws (full richness)

### Adjust Choke Cables

unclip choke cable clamps

assure full closure of choke cam

loosen fast idle lock nut and screw in fast idle screw to fully clear choke cam

re clamp cables

assure that choke cables work simultaneously and fully

### Check Temperature Compensators

remove cover screws

check for free movement by lifting plug from seat, snap back freely

adjust nut until valve just seats and no more

### Check Dashpot Pistons Free Travel

check for free movement of pistons by lifting w/ finger, let drop and click check needle bias towards throttle plates

### add 5W20 oil to within 1/4" of top of piston rod tube

### Check Carb Body Ventilation Holes

check seals to assure no obstruction of vent holes

### Check 1° & 2° Throttle Spindle End Seals

check for cracks or leaks (spray ends with WD40 and note any engine speed change)

### Balance Airflow and Adjust Throttle Idle Speed

unscrew throttle stop screws until completely closed

screw in stop screws until just contacting throttle spindle stops

screw in 1½ turns to open throttles

start engine and warm to normal

align synchronizing tool on air horn to assure air opening not blocked

match air flow of each carb by adjusting throttle stop screws

retighten 1° throttle spindle clamp so that carburetor throttles work

together

screw in or out each throttle stop screw equally to set engine idle speed to 750 rpm

### Reattach Linkages

turn engine off

reattach 1° throttle rod and clip to throttle spindle

assure no binding of throttle linkage movement

adjust throttle rods if needed to eliminate any premature opening of throttle

reattach 2° throttle rods and clips to throttle spindle

reconnect vacuum balancer hose between carbs

reinstall dashpot piston dampers

### Adjust I dle Mixture Richness

restart engine

### separately lift each piston within the carburetor opening about $\frac{1}{4}$ ":

- a. if the engine speed increases and continues faster, then screw idle trim screw out to reduce mixture richness
- b. if the engine speed decreases, then screw idle trim screw in to increase mixture richness (closed = full richness)
- c. if the engine speed momentarily increases and returns, then mixture is correct
- d. exhaust should be regular and even sounding:
  - i. if irregular, splashy misfiring, colorless exhaust, then mixture is too weak
  - ii. if rhythmic, regular misfiring, black sooty exhaust, then mixture is too rich
- e. readjust idle speed to 750 rpm if necessary by screwing in or out each throttle stop screw equally to set engine idle speed to 750 rpm

### Adjust Fast Idle Speed

### screw out fast idle screw to about 1/16" (0.067") clearance of choke cam

tighten fast idle screw lock nut

set choke limiting cam spindle by turning screw so that slot is aligned

↔ for winter and **†** for summer

# GREEN ONIONS

n a sleepy Sunday
afternoon in Memphis in
1962, four jobbing
musicians rolled into Stax
studio to record a jingle
for a health tonic. The men formed an
unusual ensemble for that time and
place: a mix of black and white players,
including a classically trained 17-yearold high school student, Booker T

Jones, at the keyboard.

When the jingle's vocalist (rockabilly pioneer Billy Lee Riley) failed to materialise, the musicians began jamming a 12-bar blues. Stax's cofounder Jim Stewart pricked up his ears. He heard a single — "Behave Yourself" — in the groove they'd found. But to release it, the band would need a name — and a B-side.

The name came easy: Booker T was clearly a star and they had all been impressed by the British MG sports car the studio engineer had parked outside. (Later they'd have to pretend that the "MG" in Booker T & the MG's stood for "Memphis Group" after British Leyland made it clear it didn't want its brand associated with R&B music.) But they were stumped for a B-side until the group's guitarist, Steve Cropper, recalled a riff that Jones had played for him two weeks earlier.

Jones had honed that riff on a school piano, inspired by the music theory he

taking the part of Cropper's guitar.

was studying at the time. In his 2019 memoir, *Time Is Tight*, he recalls wondering: "What if the bottom bass note went up while the top note of the triad went down, like in the Bach fugues and cantatas?" The quirky 12/8 time signature allowed him to coil a 3/4 waltz time within a steady 4/4 pulse. Cropper punctuated the cool groove with fiery guitar flicks. Drummer Al Jackson and bassist Lewie Steinberg (later replaced by Donald "Duck" Dunn) kept their parts classily uncluttered. They recorded the track in one take.


"Took 15-20 minutes. Tops," Cropper told Uncut magazine in 2017. Sensing that they might have made a dance hit, the guitarist took the disc to a DJ at a local R&B station who liked it so much he played it four times in a row. "The phones lit up," said Cropper.

They needed a name for the track. Jones recalls: "Lewie was saying it was so funky it stinks. Al said, 'It stinks like green onions."

Reissued as an A-side in August 1962, "Green Onions" flew to number three on the Billboard Hot 100 and became the title track of Booker T & the MG's' debut album. Dozens of covers followed, among them a muzaky 1963 version on The Surfaris' album *Wipe Out.* Jones's groove was more powerfully (if cheekily) repurposed as the bed for Sonny Boy Williamson's blues single "Help Me", with Williamson's heartbroken harmonica

Count Basie gave it a genial big band treatment in 1967; two years later synth pioneer Dick Hyman recorded an electronic version that sounds as though it was made by stoned creatures from the TV animation

The Clangers.
In 1978 Cropper joined the Blues

Brothers, the Saturday Night Live sketch-band fronted by actors Dan Ackroyd and John Belushi. The band's snappy cover of "Green Onions" appears on their 1980 album Made in America. The track finally broke the top 10 in the UK in 1979 after it was

featured on the soundtrack to Quadrophenia, the film based on The Who's 1973 rock opera. In 2019, star Leslie Ash told Gigwise that on set "it was always 'Green Onions' that we were asked to dance to".

Despite the simple versatility of its core riff, the song has not been widely sampled. The most notable example dates from 1996, when "That Girl" by Maxi Priest (feat Shaggy) used it as a base from which to pay tribute to "a gangsta kinda lover . . . MMMmm."

As the Stax house band, Booker T & the MG's played on many of the label's classic hits for the likes of Otis Redding, Wilson Pickett and Sam

& Dave. But Jones lost heart after Redding's death in 1967 and the assassination of Martin Luther King in 1968. He left Memphis for California at the end of the decade.

In his memoir he expressed frustration at the way the MG's were expected to embody an ideal of racial harmony.

"The MG's did love each other," he wrote. But "as we were held up more and more as an example to the world of how integration could work, it became more and more a veneer."

### Meet Others:




