EXHAUST NOTE

The Big Tool Contest Results

This quest was to design the smallest, lightest, and most useful tools that one should pack when motoring in an LBC.

What follows is a list you can print out and mimic or mock as you please. The list was compiled by taxing the combined thoughts of MGOB brain power and judged by men of superior character and LBC knowledge. Now that you know the tools and parts, we'll let Chris teach you how to use them at the monthly meetings.

The list is broken down into every day and extended driving (in which we added a few spare parts). Here are some random notes:

- You could carry a spare ignition setup, or we found on eBay a complete 45D electronic distributor for \$45 and free shipping. The parts alone at most with shipping is over 58 bucks. You do the math.
- How good/old is your current distributor. Are the springs weak? Does the vacuum even work? Maybe the current distributor becomes the spare?
- MG's placement of the heater valve was suboptimal. These units are prone to failure. A new one is \$32 that I got on eBay with free delivery. Moss is \$32 plus about another \$13 in shipping???? Another math problem? There is a much more expensive option out there That moves the valve away from the distributor. You may think; why

buy a Mercedes to go to Walmart? *OH*, and the originality factor: *Mon Deu!*

- How old is your heater valve? Again, maybe the current one becomes the spare.
- An auxiliary fuel pump with long connectors is a must. There were some questions about whether these pumps were strong enough. The option we offer is NOT a fuel pump; it is a fluid transfer pump of a desal engine. It has the right 2-4# pressure and is capable of pumping multiple liters per minute. I may go ahead and mount mine under the bonnet and it will be one less thing in my tool bag.
- Storing tools was also discussed a bit. Older 6-volt MGs came with two battery holders. New MGs still have the space for that second holder. (*Insert "saws-all" here*) Either way you could drop one of the MG plastic battery boxes in this space. A wonderful space for your stash.

Exhausted now, Well I hope this helps you all. Safety Fast

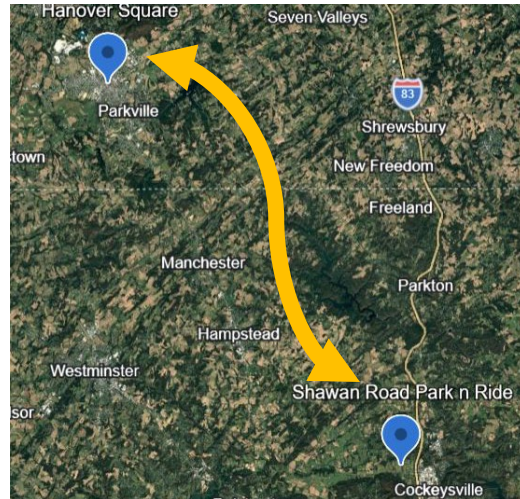

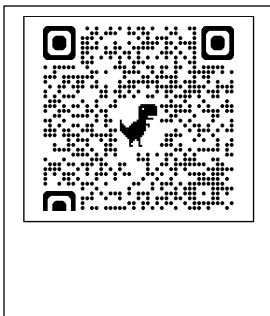

FT. WASHINGTON'S HOPE LODGE

Hope Lodge was built between 1743 and 1748 by Samuel Morris, a prosperous Quaker entrepreneur. Morris acted as a farmer, ship owner, miller, iron-master, shop-owner, and owner of the mill now known as Mather Mill. Hope Lodge is an excellent example of early Georgian Architecture, and it is possible that Edmund Woolley, architect of Independence Hall, offered advice in building. Samuel Morris owned the estate until his death in 1770, when it was inherited by his brother Joshua. Joshua in turn sold the property and dwelling to another Philadelphia merchant, William West.

In 1953, ownership of the house was transferred to the Hope Lodge Foundation, and in 1957, to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Today, Hope Lodge is administered by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission with the Friends of Hope Lodge, a non-profit support group formed to assist with operations at the site.

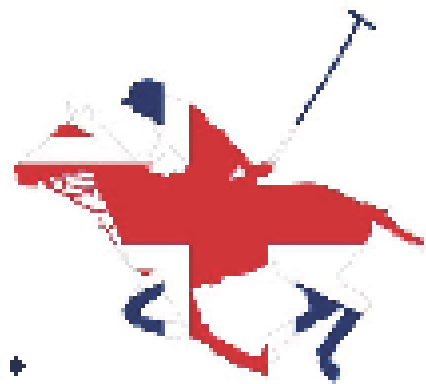
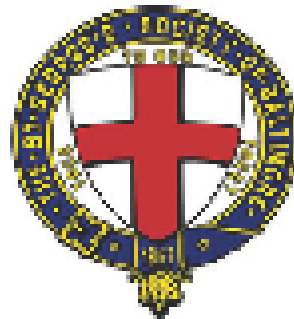

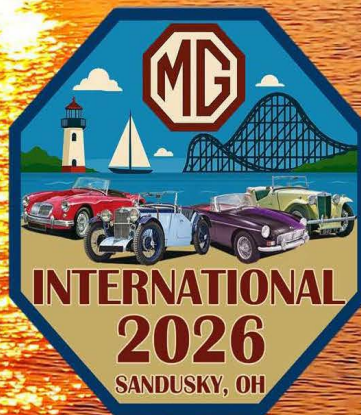
